ORDINANCE NO. 1991-48

COUNCIL FORM OF GOVERNMENT FOR BARNWELL COUNTY

(An Ordinance for the purpose of a Commission to oversee the function of the Barnwell County Airport.)

WHEREAS:

1. The Barnwell county Council finds that to provide for future growth at the airport, and in Barnwell County that it is necessary to have a Board of Commission for the operation of the Barnwell County Airport.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE BARNWELL COUNTY COUNCIL THAT:

Section 1: This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority conferred by Section 4-9-30 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, as amended, to promote the public health, safety, moral, convenience, order, prosperity, and general welfare of the present and future inhabitants of Barnwell County, South Carolina.

Section 2: There is hereby created the Barnwell County Airport Commission which shall consist of eight (8) members to be elected by the County Council of Barnwell County. The Commission shall annually elect from its membership its Chairman and Vice Chairman. The functions of the Airport Commission shall include management of the airport and aeronautical needs and requirements of the County and surrounding area.

Section 3: The Airport Commission shall advise from time to time the County Council concerning airport and aeronautical needs and requirements and development plans for providing for said needs and requirements.

Section 4: Membership and Appointment. The Barnwell County Airport Commission shall be comprised of eight (8) members to be appointed by Barnwell County Council. The eight (8) members of the Board shall be comprised of one (1) member from each of the Council Districts and one (1) from Barnwell County Council as ex-officio member.

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If no member can be found from within a Council District then the district appointment shall be at large. The initial Board of the Airport Commission shall be appointed as follows:

All odd District and the Ex-officio member shall be for three years, and all even District members shall be for two years. All new and renewal appointments after the expiration of the initial terms of the initial Board shall be for three year terms. No member shall serve more than three (3) consecutive terms. In case of any vacancy prior to the expiration of a regular term, the appointment to fill the vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term shall be made in the same manner as provided for the original appointment.

Appointment recommendations shall be made to the County Council Committee responsible for the Barnwell County Airport Commission. Recommendations made to this Committee, may be made by the council person for the specific districts in question, however, other Council members or other individuals from Barnwell County may also make recommendations regarding appointees to the Council Committee. The Council Committee shall review the submissions for appointments and recommend a slate of nominees as they deem appropriate to the full Council. The Board Member or Members shall then be chosen by vote of the full Barnwell County Council.

Section 5: Compensation: The members shall be compensated One Hundred twenty (\$120.00) dollars per year for travel expenses and shall otherwise serve without compensation.

Section 6: Absenteeism. The continued absence of a member of the Commission for three (3) consecutive meetings of said Commission without just cause shall be tantamount to a resignation. The vacancy thereby created shall be filled by the County Council as set forth in Section 4 of this ordinance.

Section 7: It will be the duty and the responsibility of the Airport Commission to provide for, recommend, administer and supervise the functional needs of the County Airport and other airport or aeronautical needs of Barnwell County. Annually prepare a budget for carrying out of these duties and responsibilities, the Commission will have the authority to expend, in accordance with the County approved budget, all monies that it will receive.

acquire any equipment useful in the conduct or operation of it facilities, prescribe rules and regulations governing the use of the airport, fix rates and other charges for the use of it facilities, establish any necessary policies for the operation of the airport and proper to the functioning of the Commission or the Barnwell County Council. The employment, discharge or compensation of the airport manager shall be subject to the approval of the County Council.

Section 8: All rules, regulations, policies or rates and other monetary charges concerning airport facilities shall be approved by the Commission and submitted to the County Council unless disapproved by County Council, the rules, regulations, policies or rates and other monetary charges shall be effective one(1) month from the date forwarded to the County Council.

Section 9: Records & Audits: The board shall at all times keep full and accurate accounts of its acts and operation and of its receipts and expenditures, and at least annually, complete audit of its affairs shall be made by the Barnwell County Auditors.

COUNCIL FORM OF GOVERNMENT FOR BARNWELL COUNTY
(An Ordinance Creating the Barnwell County Airport Advisory Board)

WHEREAS:

The Barnwell County Council finds that to provide for future growth and enhanced use of the Barnwell County Airport it is advantageous to create an Advisory Board to the Barnwell County Airport; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE BARNWELL COUNTY COUNCIL THAT:

Section 1: Authority. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority conferred by Section 4-9-30 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, as amended, to promote the public health, safety, moral, convenience, order, prosperity, and general welfare of the present and future inhabitants of Barnwell County, South Carolina.

Section 2: Establishment. There is hereby created the Barnwell County Airport Advisory Board.

Section 3: Membership and Appointment. The Barnwell County Airport Advisory Board shall be comprised of eight (8) members to be appointed by Barnwell County Council. The eight (8) members of the Board shall be comprised of one (1) member from each of the Council Districts and one (1) member of Barnwell County Council as an ex-officio member. If no member can be found from within a Council District then that district appointment shall be at large.

The initial members of the Airport Advisory Board shall be the persons currently serving as members of the Barnwell County Airport Commission. Each member of the Advisory Board shall serve the remainder of his/her term.

All new and renewal appointments after the expiration of the initial terms of the initial Board shall be for three year terms. No member shall serve more than three (3) consecutive terms. In a case of any vacancy prior to the expiration of a regular term, the appointment to fill the vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term shall be made in the same manner as provided for the original appointment.

Appointment recommendations shall be made to the Barnwell County Council Safety and Judicial Committee. Recommendations made to this Committee, may be made by the council person for the specific district in question, however, other Council members or other individuals from Barnwell County may also make recommendations regarding appointees to the Council Committee. The Committee shall review the submissions for appointment and recommend a

ate of nominees as they deem appropriate to the full Council. The Board Member or Members shall then be chosen by vote of the full Barnwell County Council.

Section 4: Officers. The members of the board shall annually elect a Chairman and Vice-Chairman. The Chairman shall preside over all meetings and shall conduct all meetings in accordance with Roberts Rules of Order, Revised Ed. The Chairman shall have the right to vote (except where a conflict exists) but shall vote last in any roll call votes. The Vice-Chairman shall serve as Chairman in the case of the Chairmans disability or absence.

Section 5: Duties of Board. The Airport Advisory Board shall advise from time to time the County Council concerning airport and aeronautical needs and requirements and development plans for providing for said needs and requirements, including:

- a) The Airport Advisory Board recommending the acquisition of any equipment useful in the conduct or operation of its facilities;
- b) The Airport Advisory Board recommending rules and regulations governing the use of the airport;
- c) The Airport Advisory Board shall recommend rates and other charges for the use of its facilities;
- d) The Airport Advisory Board shall recommend any necessary policies beneficial to the functioning of the airport as well as such other powers necessary and proper to the functioning of the Board or the airport which may from time to time be requested by the Barnwell County Council.

Section 6: Compensation. The members shall be compensated One Hundred twenty (\$120.00) dollars per year for travel expenses and shall otherwise serve without compensation.

Section 7: Absenteeism. The continued absence of a member of the Advisory Board for three (3) consecutive meetings of said Commission without just cause shall be tantamount to a resignation. The vacancy thereby created shall be filled by the County Council as set forth in Section 3 of this ordinance.

Section 8: Meetings. The board shall meet at least the first Thursday of January, April, July and October, unless that date falls on a legal holiday. In that event, the board shall meet the following Thursday. Special Meetings may be called by the Chairman or majority of Board members. At least 4 voting members shall be required for a meeting. At least twenty-four (24) hours notice must be given of all regular and special meetings. Minutes shall be kept of all meetings and shall be filed with the Clerk of Council.

Section 9: This Ordinance shall become effective on this 3rd and final reading and vote. Barnwell County Ordinance 1991-48 is repealed.

Section 6: Absenteeism. The continued absence of a member of the Commission for three (3) consecutive meetings of said Commission without just cause shall be tantamount to a resignation. The vacancy thereby created shall be filled by the County Council as set forth in section 4 of the ordinance.

Section 7: It will be the duty and the responsibility of the Airport Commission to provide for, recommend, administer and supervise the functioning of the County Airport and any other airport or aeronautical needs of Barnwell County. Annually prepare a budget for carrying out these duties and responsibilities, the commission will have the authority to expend, in accordance with the County approved budget, all monies that it will receive, acquire any equipment useful in the conduct or operation of its facilities, prescribe rules and regulations governing the use of the airport, fix rates and other charges for the use of its facilities, establish any necessary policies beneficial to the functioning of the airport as well as such other further powers necessary and proper to the functioning of the Commission or the airport or which it may from time to time be directed by the Barnwell County council. The employment, discharge

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and compensation of the airport manager shall be subject to the approval of the County Council.

Section 8: All rules, regulations, policies or rates and other monetary charges concerning airport facilities shall be first approved by the Commission and submitted to the County Council. Unless disapproved by County Council, the rules, regulation, policies or rates and other monetary charges shall become effective one (1) month from the date forwarded to the County Council.

Section 9: Records & Audits: The board shall at all times keep full and accurate accounts of its acts and operations and of its receipts and expenditures, and at least annually, a complete audit of its affairs shall be made by the Barnwell County Auditors.

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-143

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1997-97, An Ordinance for the purpose of a Commission To Oversee the Function of the Barnwell County Airport

WHEREAS, the by Ordinance NO. 1997-97 the Barnwell County Council created the Barnwell County Airport Commission to advise the County Council concerning the airport, its needs, requirements and development plans, and

WHEREAS, the ordinance created a commission of eight members and the Council finds that it is in the public interest to have a ten member commission, Section 2 and Section 4 of Ordinance No. 1997-97 is hereby amended and substituted to read as follows:

Section 2: There is hereby created the Barnwell County Airport Commission which shall consist of ten (10) members to be elected by the County Council of Barnwell County. The Commission shall annually elect from its membership its Chairperson and Vice Chairperson. The functions of the Airport Commission shall include management of the airport and aeronautical needs and requirements of the County and surrounding area.

Section 4: The Barnwell County Airport Commission shall be comprised of ten (10) members to be appointed by Barnwell County Council. The ten members shall be composed of one citizen appointed from each county council district, two members appointed at-large and one member of the Barnwell County Council appointed as an ex-officio member of the Barnwell County Airport Commission.

All other Sections of Ordinance No. 1997-97 including the balance of Section 4, shall retain their full force and effect unless otherwise amended by the Barnwell County Council.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its third and final reading and passage by a majority of the Barnwell County Council.


